Mr President,

The Building and Wood Workers International (BWI) condemns the verdict passed against Mahoud Salehi the former President of the Bakery Workers' Association of the city of Saqez by the Kurdistan Court of Appeal. According to the latest information, Bro. Salehi arrested on 9 April 2007 was sentenced to one year imprisonment and a three year suspended prison sentence.

It is very clear that Salehi has been sentenced for his labour activities, particularly given the fact that the initial arrests and the final charges were made in connection with his attempts to participate in a May Day 2004 celebration in Saqez. This verdict shows that your Government disregards workers' fundamental rights enshrined in ILO Conventions, such as freedom of association and the right to celebrate the International Workers' Day.

We urge you to put an end to all the sentences passed against Mahmoud Salehi and release him immediately and unconditionally.
